From the Editor's Desk...

War in the Middle-east Deepens: May be Prelude to a Third World-War

Lebanon's Hezbollah group confirmed that its leader and one of its founders, Hassan Nasralla, was killed in an Israelite air-strike in Beirut the previous day. A statement said, "Nasrallah has joined his fellow martyrs" and the group vowed to "continue the holy war against the enemy and in support of Palestine."

The Israeli military said it carried out a precise airstrike while Hezbollah leadership met at their headquarters in Dahiyeh, south of Beirut. Nasrallah, who led Hezbollah for more than three decades, is by far the most powerful target to be killed by Israel in weeks of intensified fighting with Hezbollah. The Lebanese health ministry said six people were killed and 91 injured in the Beirut strikes, which levelled six apartment buildings. Ali Karki, the commander of Hezbollah's Southern Front, and additional Hezbollah commanders were also killed in the attack, the Israilimilitary said. Iran said a prominent General in its paramilitary Revolutionary Guard died in the attack. Abhas Nilforushan, 58 were killed in Lebanan. Iran's state-run IRNA news agency reported.

Lt. Colonel NadavShoshani, an Israeli army spokesperson, said the airstrike was based on years of tracking Nasrallah alongwith "read time information" that made it viable Shoshani declined to say how they were used in the strike or provide an estimate on civilian deaths.

In Beirut armed men fired shots in the air and shutdown shops in parts of Beirut and Hexbollah supporters said they were in a state of shock and disbelief after the death of the Lebanese armed group leader Sayyed Hassan Nasrallah. His death marked a devastating blow to Hezbollah as it reels from an intense campaign of Israili attacks, and even as the news emerged some of the group's supporters were desperately hoping that somehow he was still alive. "God, I hope it's not true. Its's a disaster if it's true," said Zahraa, a young woman who was displaced over, might from Hezbollah's strong hold in the Southern Beirut. "He was leading us. He was everything to us."

"He was leading us. He was everything to us. We were under his wings," she told Reuters tearfully by phone. She said other displaced people around her fainted or began to scream when they received notifications on their phone of Hezbollah's statement confirming his death. In some parts of Beirut armed men came into shops and told owners to shut them down, witnesses said. It was not immediately clear what faction the armed men belonged to. Sprays of gunshots were heard in the Hamra district in the city's west as mourners fired in the air, residents there said, "were heard chanting for you Nosrullah."

5) YOUR COMPANY'S RECRUITMENT PROCESS AND YOUR REMARKS ON IT

The hiring process at Infosys typically follows a structured sequence of stages to assess candidates for both technical and non-technical roles. Candidates can apply online through the Infosys career portal or be referred by a current employee. There will be two rounds of technical interviews where Infosys will test your fundamental knowledge on the domain. The HR interview gauges the candidate's fit for Infosys' culture, communication skills, and overall personality. This stage includes questions on career goals, strengths and weaknesses, situational questions, and willingness to relocate or work in shifts. Behavioral questions and discussions around the candidate's resume, internships, or project work are common. My remark would be to stay positive and truthful during the process. Avoid beating around the bush during interview.

To all the juniors, I encourage you to embrace every opportunity for learning, both inside and outside the classroom. Focus on building a strong foundation in your field, but don't shy away from exploring diverse interests—it can spark creativity and open unexpected doors. Work on enhancing your communication and leadership skills, as they will set you apart in any field. Most importantly, stay adaptable and open to change, because personal growth and career success often come from stepping out of your comfort zone and seizing new challenges.




